SEED LA, joins the nation's first and only network of public, college-prep boarding schools designed for all students who need—and deserve—a 24-hour learning environment to achieve their full potential.

In partnership with Los Angeles County and LA Metro, SEED LA, is a high school that provides all students regardless of their background or identity with a pathway to degree attainment and career readiness in transportation, STEM, and humanities.

Students live and learn on campus, five-days-a-week—checking in on Sunday evening and checking out on Friday afternoon*. Transportation for all students is provided from bus hubs located throughout Los Angeles County. With this additional time, SEED has built a community of support that empowers students to own their educational journeys and to succeed in college and beyond. Our holistic model brings a full suite of services—academic, social, emotional, physical, and mental health services—under one roof and customized to meet each student's needs.

SEED LA's vibrant student life program is an integral part of our inclusive community, designed to nurture and support all students regardless of their background or identity.

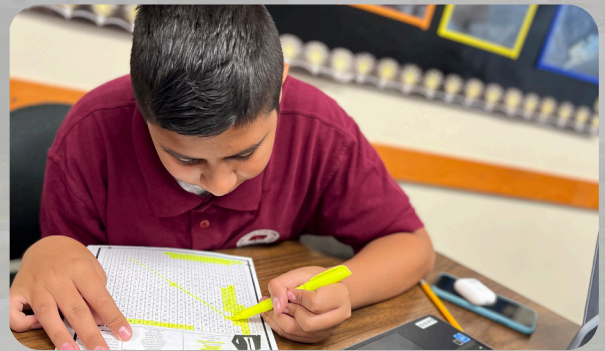
